



## **Bank of England Museum**

### Description:

Try lifting a real gold bar. Visit the museum, which traces the history of the Bank from 1694 to its role today as the nation's bank. A magnificent reconstruction of Sir John Soane's 18th century Banking Hall gives an atmosphere of the early bank and interactive displays highlight the roles and functions of the modern day bank. Other sections cover the Bank's history, banknote printing and gold. Try your hand at dealing on the exchange market by pitting your wits against a computerised simulation. There are lots of special events for children, special educational and interactive "money" presentations and also activity sheets.
