Holkham Hall is one of Britain's most majestic stately homes. It is situated in a Deer Park on the beautiful north Norfolk coast. Home to seven generations of the Earls of Leicester, this classic 18th Century Palladian Style mansion is a living treasure house of artistic and architectural history. The Bygones Museum and History of Farming Exhibition invite visitors to step back in time. The Museum, with its displays of domestic and agricultural memorabilia allows visitors to relive memories or learn about life in times gone by. For refreshments we have the Stables Caf  in the Pottery Courtyard. The self-service Caf  provides snacks, light lunches, deliciously tempting cakes and our very own mouth-watering Holkham Ice Cream.
