Pashley Manor Gardens offer a sumptuous blend of romantic landscaping, imaginative planting and fine old trees, fountains, springs and large ponds. A number of different gardens have been created within the 11 acres, allowing the visitor to travel from blazing colour to cool creams, greens and golds. Permanent exhibition and sale of sculpture and botanical art. There is a licensed Garden Room Cafe with seating for 80 which offers buffet service for light lunches, afternoon tea, coffee and cakes. Pashley prides itself on providing, where possible, locally sourced and homemade food. During warm weather visitors can enjoy their refreshments on the terrace overlooking the moat or in the Jubilee Courtyard. Gift Shop and Plant Sales.
